



CRM INTENSIVE RESEARCH PROGRAMMES



This IRP focuses on the latest developments of the Anthropological Theory of the Didactic (ATD) and its links with other approaches in Mathematics Education. The programme brings together leading researchers from all over the world to present their works in recent trends and methodologies. The main creator of the ATD, Yves Chevallard, will participate in all the courses.

The programme has been designed to be interesting for both junior and senior researchers. Primary, secondary and tertiary teachers, as well as teacher educators are also welcome.

The programme is structured into four advanced two-week courses. Each course includes a first part mainly based on lectures and workshops led by researchers. In the second part, more collaborative activities like seminars, students' presentations and discussion will be organized.

Participants can attend one or several courses, for only the first part of each course or for the whole course.
